St. Paul's Pre-School must have a Parent Committee to help with the management and finance of the whole organisation. Due to our constitution and charitable status, the Pre-School cannot run if there is no Committee.

The Parent Committee manages itself, and so needs three Officers to take a leading role - two Co-Chairs and one Treasurer. They run the meetings, plan and put together the fundraisers which happen during the year, with the support of the Pre-School staff and as many parents as possible.

There are usually six Committee meetings in the school year. Sometimes smaller groups meet apart from this to plan specific things for the Christmas or Summer Fair.

Each year we ask new parents to join and each year parents move on as their children go up to Primary School. We need parents to volunteer for the Officers roles.

The A.G.M. is very important to our Pre-School life. At this meeting our Committee and Administrator report to parents on our financial status, events during the year and any challenges ahead.

Since 2015 we have planned this as an event to open the new Pre-School year, and have invited Deacon Dave to lead a short Liturgy with activities for the children. We want to involve all the family and provide free time for parents to attend the meeting.
