Promoting British Values at St Paul's Pre-School

Democracy:

We listen to children's and parent's views. Our policy on Achieving Positive Behaviour emphasises that we prioritise supporting children in the development of their social skills so that they learn to consider the views, feelings, needs and rights of others.

The Rule of Law:

We consistently reinforce our high expectations of children. Children are taught the value and reasons behind our expectations: that our rules are there to protect us and that everyone has a responsibility to the whole group.

Individual Liberty:

Within Pre-School, children are actively encouraged to make choices, knowing that they are in a safe and supportive environment. As a Pre-School we educate and provide boundaries for young children to make choices safely, through our provision of a safe environment and empowering teaching. Children are encouraged to know, understand and exercise their rights and personal freedoms.

Mutual Respect:

At St Paul's Pre-School our Catholic beliefs are the foundation of our ethos. We are fully committed to including all children. Our shared values confirm our commitment to act as good role models for the children as we demonstrate caring, sharing and listening to others. We support children in developing respect for others and learning how actions and words can affect other people.

Tolerance of those of Different Faiths and Beliefs:

At St Paul's Pre-School we care for children from a wide range of backgrounds and countries of origin. We work hard to ensure that all our families feel respected and included. We intend to enhance children's understanding of different faiths and beliefs by participating in a range of celebrations throughout the year. Children have the opportunity to dress-up in clothes and try different foods from other cultures and we encourage parents and carers to participate and support our multi-cultural events.
